- National Climate Change Response Strategy (Basis)
- Stakeholder Consultations (Mandate, Location, TORs)
- Established under Ministry of Finance

(responsible for mobilization & distribution of resources, national planning & budgeting and has convening power over other Ministries).

- Clarification of lead institutional mandates
- Slow deployment of staff
- Harmonization of Government & MDBs guidelines and procedures




## INTERIM INTER-MINISTERIAL CLIMATE CHANGE SECRETARIAT (ICCS)

#### **FUNCTIONS**

- National coordinating body for all climate change related activities in the country
  - Implementation by Line Ministries
- Core team from Key Ministries
- Growing portfolio (GCF, SREP, BioCarbon, UNJP, Green Growth Strategy)
- Funding: PPCR and Government Counter-part Funding

#### COUNTRY OWNERSHIP: KEY LESSONS

#### Participatory Process:

 Leadership by Government and engagement of traditional and local authorities, including local communities, gives legitimacy and acceptability

#### Considerations for Sustainability

- Institutional arrangements for climate change (location, structures) must be not be imposed but agreed internally by national stakeholders
- Strong political will essential (e.g. results in support for budget allocation)

#### •Value Addition by Coordination Mechanism:

 Relevance and non-duplication of efforts with sector ministries and institutions
