# CIF Program Design Learning and Knowledge Management

- Agreed CIF design documents stress the importance of establishing effective systems for the sharing of lessons as a critical part of the overall CIF mission and the sunset feature of the funds.
  - KM for successful implementation of activities
  - As strategy for multiplying impacts through effective sharing of lessons
- PPCR objectives are:
  - Pilot and demonstrate approaches for integration of climate risk and climate resilience into development policies and planning
  - Strengthen capacities at the national levels to integrated climate resilience into development planning
  - Scale-up and leverage climate resilient investment, building on other ongoing initiatives
  - Enable learning *learning by doing* and sharing of lessons at country, regional and global levels.
- To achieve the PPCR's central learning objective, program implementation needs to capture lessons continuously from start to end, at individual pilot and at PPCR program level
- At program level: dedicated resources to be allocate to ensure that KM is fully integrated into the 11 pilots through a <u>Global Support Program</u>
- ☐ Initial focus of the GSP on PPCR, but will encompass the FIP and SREP as they become operational.

## **Global Support Program**

- ☐ The CIF Admin will establish a Global Support Program to
  - Provide the "glue" to bring together all the individual pilots programs and promote learning among them
  - Facilitate learning across pilots
  - Serve as a "help desk"
  - Disseminate lessons among broad range of stakeholder
  - Interacting with and ensure that lessons are transmitted regularly to UNFCCC, Adaptation Fund Board, etc.
- □PPCR Pilot level
  - The SPCR should include, and budget for KM

#### **Global Support Program**

- Key elements
  - ☐ To ensure that lessons are captured within each pilot
  - and disseminated across the pilots
  - to whole range of stakeholders
  - at global and regional levels
  - shared knowledge products,
  - cost effectiveness
  - providing expertise and tools to participating countries
- □ All of these elements need to be embedded in the targeted program (e.g. PPCR) from the start

### **Tools and Approaches for GSP**

- Functional website for each program
  - under the CIF platform
- Annual meeting of pilot countries
  - Including the Annual partnership forum
- ☐ Targeted products
- □ Tools and knowledge resources, including through "living" and evolving "sourcebooks" for each program
- Promote robust results measurement and performance (project/program)
- Collaborate with and build synergies with existing learning and knowledge platforms of MDB and other development partners
  - e.g. Adaptation learning mechanism, Communities of Practice, GDLN
- Communicate lessons to existing and emerging financing sources
  - e.g. Adaptation Fund, GEF, UNFCCC
- ☐ Technical support
  - e.g. training of trainers, media training, south-south exchanges

#### Target audiences

- Diverse set of stakeholder
  - Need for customized products
  - Communicating experiences and lessons
  - Need clear objectives, modalities and timing
- Stakeholders
  - Government local scale-up
  - NGOs and civil society
  - Private sectors
  - Global environment conventions
- Dissemination and Implementation (as outreach)

## Key next steps for GSP

- Develop the scope, work program & budget
- Develop tools and knowledge resources to support the pilot countries
- Provide both support and quality control to the country and regional pilots to ensure effective incorporation of knowledge management in each pilot
- 4. Capture and promote exchange of lessons and expertise across and among the pilot programs
- 5. Contribute to promoting robust measurement of results through use of performance frameworks for the pilots
