As you are aware, Jordan is one of the eligible countries to access the Clean Technology Fund (CTF), and is a member of the MENA CSP Program. We highly recognise and appreciate this important initiative, which directly responds to Jordan's need of accessing additional soft financing resources.

In this context, and as you may be also aware, the Government of Jordan (GOJ) has ambitious plans to utilise renewable energy and implement energy saving measures in all sectors. As GOJ's energy strategy aims to diversify energy resources and increase the share of renewable energy resources in the energy mix, to reach 10% by the year 2020.

In this regard, we would like to request dispatching a mission to Jordan as soon as possible, to work with the concerned institutions on developing an investment plan. This investment plan will be submitted to CTF's Administrative Unit, to look into the various possible venues of securing financing to this plan.
