The alternative livelihood schemes based on the complementarity of the two projects of the Burkina FIP program are explained in paragraphs 2.2.2, 2.2.3 and 2.2.4 in the appraisal report and in annex B1.

(b) the plan for reduction in firewood harvesting in certain areas along with the opening of roads/paths into new forest areas, including a fuller explanation of what the plan is for alternative energy and livelihoods support, and the feasibility and sustainability of those plans; also, analysis of the expected leakage associated with this plan	2.1 of annex B2.
