### 9. Food and hospitality provided at the Meetings

#### 10. Medical Insurance

The World Bank Group does not provide insurance to visitors, seminar participants, or presenters. Any traveler without international medical insurance, particularly those coming into the USA, should be cautioned about the high cost of medical care in the U.S. and should also be advised that the World Bank Group will not be responsible for their medical expenses.

Individuals should review their insurance needs prior to travel. Travelers without insurance should purchase, at a minimum, travel medical coverage for urgent care. These policies may have exclusions and limitations, such as pre-existing health conditions and pregnancy.

### 11. COVID-19 Participation Requirements and Safety Protocol

- **VACCINES:** All in-person attendees are **required to be fully vaccinated and** have their proof of vaccination (in paper or electronic format) with them at all times.
- TESTS: In-person attendees will also be asked to self-test daily in their hotels prior to
  coming to the CIF Meetings. Self-test kits will be distributed to participants upon their
  arrival to the hotel and ahead of the meetings. Additional information on tests kits
  distribution and sharing of daily self-test results will be provided in a separate email
  communication issued to the registered in-person attendees.
- MASKS: All in-person attendees are <u>mandated</u> to wear a mask that fully covers their nose and mouth when in public spaces and attending the meetings.
- Please review the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) <u>guidance</u> for the latest requirements regarding entry into the United States and international travel.
- Participants should test themselves every morning in their hotel room before coming to the World Bank. A positive test result should immediately be reported to the CIF Team via email at <u>CIFCovidResults@worldbank.org</u> (with cc to CIF\_Governance\_Team@worldbankgroup.org).
- Participants who test positive to COVID should **not** attempt to enter the meeting premises and attend the meetings.


- Participants using the Zoom Application, can send messages through the "Chat" icon to inform the CIF AU that they would like to speak.

The Climate Investment Funds (CIF) were established in 2008 to mobilize resources and trigger investments for low carbon, climate resilient development in select middle and low income countries. To date, 14 contributor countries have pledged funds to CIF that have been channeled for mitigation and adaptation interventions at an unprecedented scale in 72 recipient countries. The CIF is the largest active climate finance mechanism in the world.
